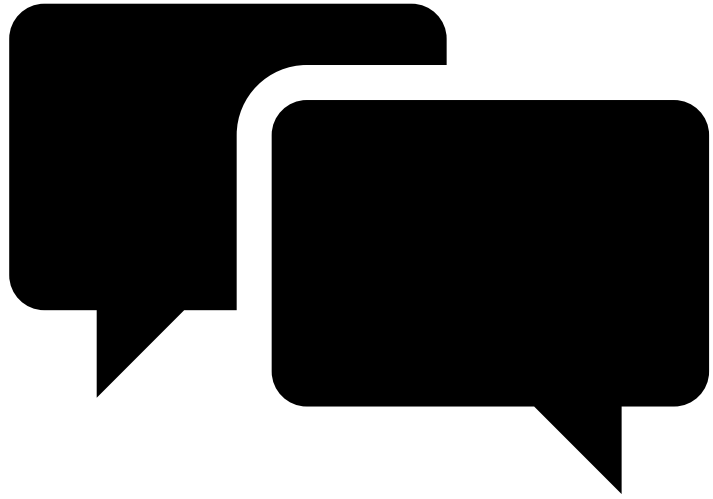

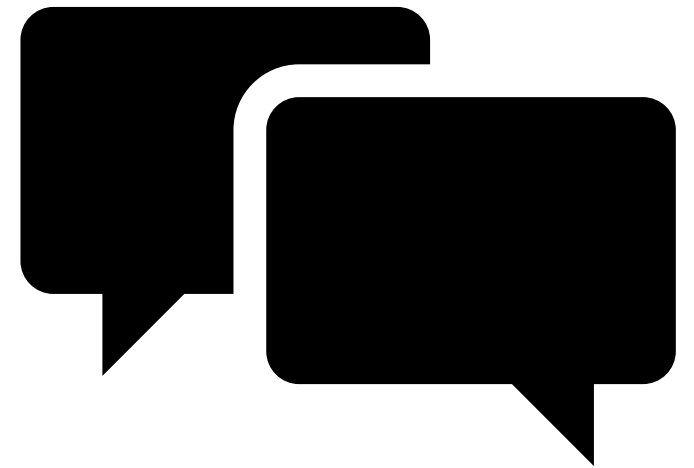
Training plans — departmental session

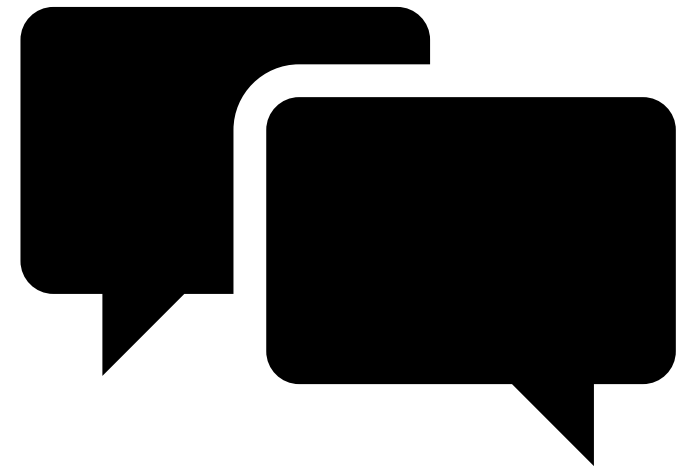
